

49 CFR 178.2 (c) Notification for USA DOT 7A Type A Packaging

Routing Instructions: *This document must be passed along with the container within your facility, or to whom the packaging is transferred, and ultimately to the personnel responsible for shipping, closure and certifying that the packaging meets all the requirements of 178.350 Specification 7A: general packaging, Type A. It must be used as a companion document to the current version of our document entitled: "49 CFR 178.2 (c) Notification for Myers, CMS and Other UN Packagings and UN Assembly Instructions for Non-Bulk MCC and CMS Packagings".*

Requirements met at the time of transfer

As fabricator of the packaging, Myers has provided test results documented on the DOT 7A Type A Test Summary on actual specific tests performed for various designs. The compliance statement on the test reports is follows:

This packaging complies with the 7A-Type A general requirements for packaging, section §173.465 (§178.350a).

Requirements not met at the time of transfer

It is the Shippers responsibility (as User / Manufacturer) to determine that this packaging conforms to all the requirements of §178.350 Specification 7A; general packaging, Type A.

Specifically, according to Part 173.465 (a) : Each packaging must meet all applicable requirements of subpart B of Part 173 of this subchapter and be designed and constructed so that it meets the requirements of §§ 173.403 , 173.410 , 173.412 , 173.415 and 173.465 of this subchapter for Type A packaging.

Due to conditions outside of the control of MCC, the person to whom the packaging is transferred (including the filler and the shipper) as User / Manufacturer, are notified that all the requirements of §§ 173.403, 173.410, 173.412 and 173.415 are not met at the time of transfer.

This requirement applies in cases when the mark "USA DOT 7A Type A" is applied to the packaging, when labels with this mark are shipped loose and /or when the end use is intended to be USA DOT 7A Type A packaging.

This document is an agreed to clause to a customers purchase order, constitutes a condition of our accepting the order and will be placed in Quality Documents submitted with the order.

A 7A Test Summary verifying that the packaging sold to you has met the testing requirements of 49 CFR 173.465 and is available upon request. It is the responsibility of the User / Manufacturer to request, support or gather information to support the certifying of the packaging.
